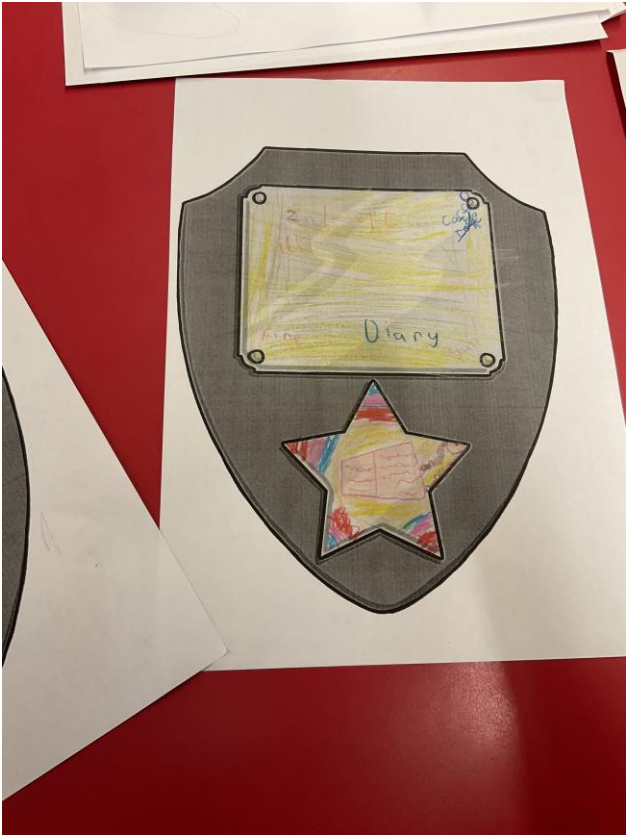
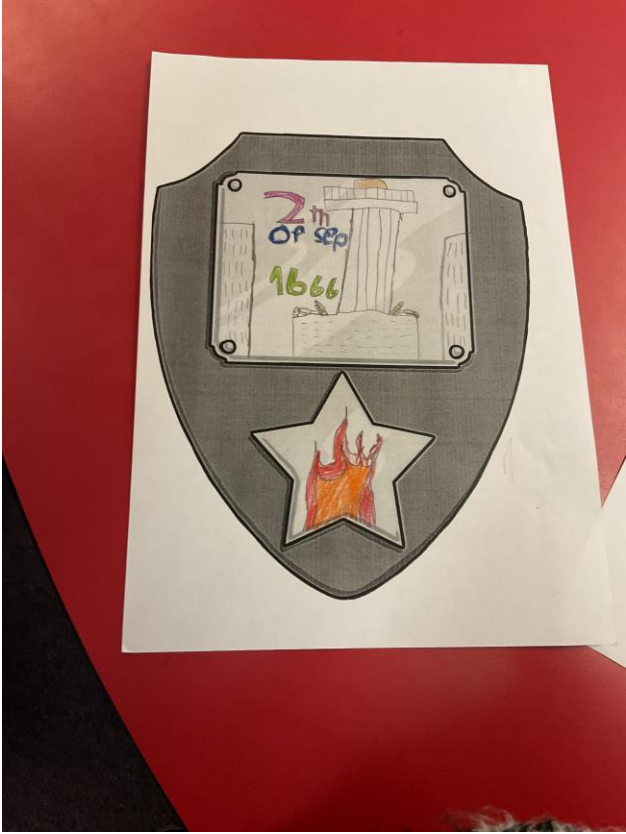


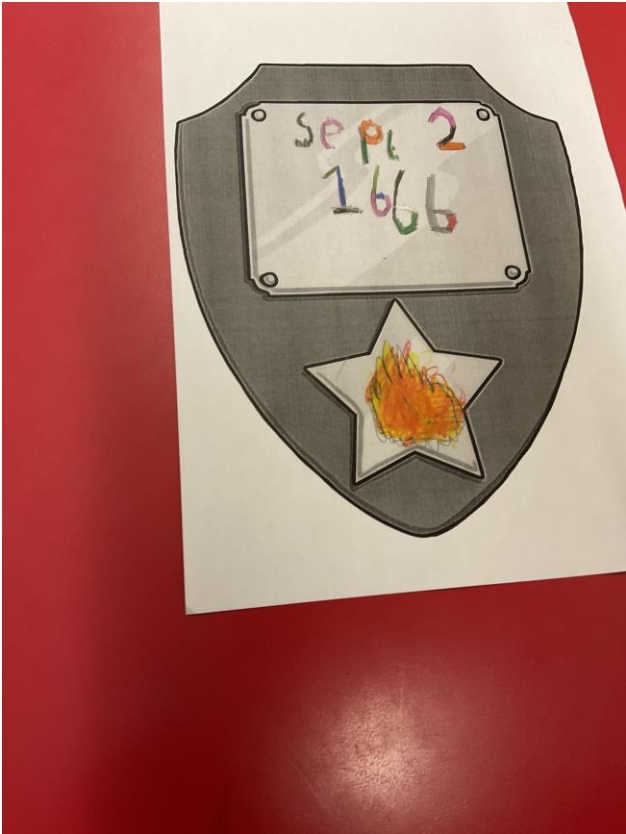
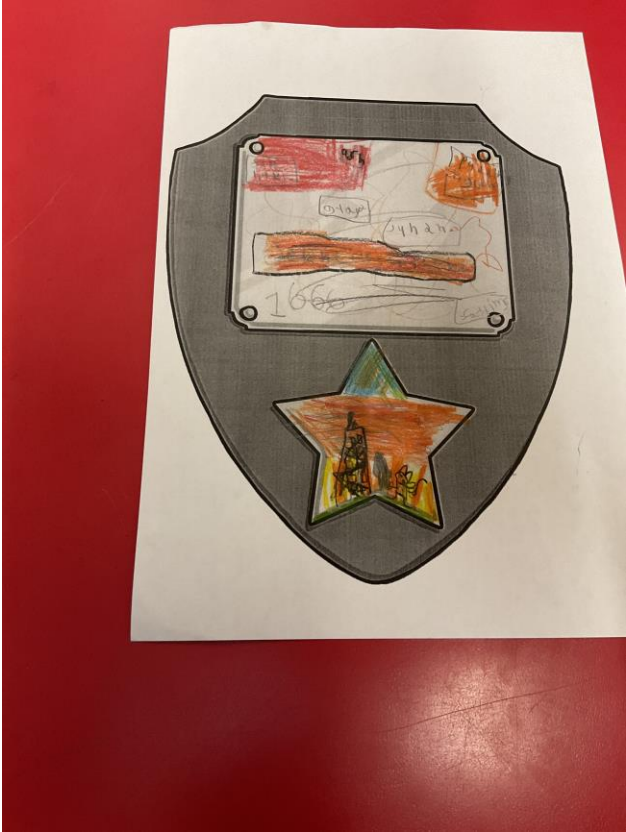




KS1

This week the children in key stage 1 have begun to work on the Christmas show. It is always a very special time in school and it is lovely to see the children's excitement and enthusiasm to learn their part. We have also been sharing what we learnt from our recent trip to Weaver Hall to complete our History topic on The Great Fire of London by learning about what happened after the fire finally stopped. We looked at ways the fire is remembered, and the children made their own plaques. In Science the children discussed what a healthy balanced diet is and chose from the food group plate to select what foods they like to eat. The children had fun talking about their favourite foods with their friends and we discussed how we should try to eat five portions of fruit and vegetables each day.

If you have walked down the LKS2 corridor this week, you have probably been able to smell freshly baked bread! Year 3 and 4 have worked well as a team to combine all the ingredients and follow instructions. The children have added herbs for flavour and kneaded and shaped the dough into a design of their own making. The children especially enjoyed tasting their bread with honey like the ancient Greeks. You may have been lucky enough to try some of their bread when they brought it home- although we don't think a lot of it did make it that far!









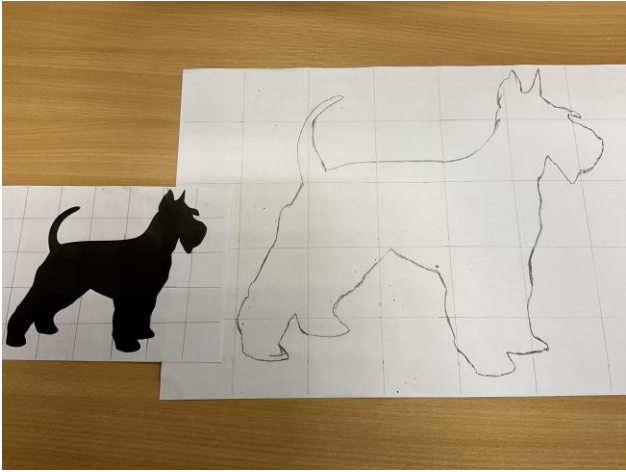
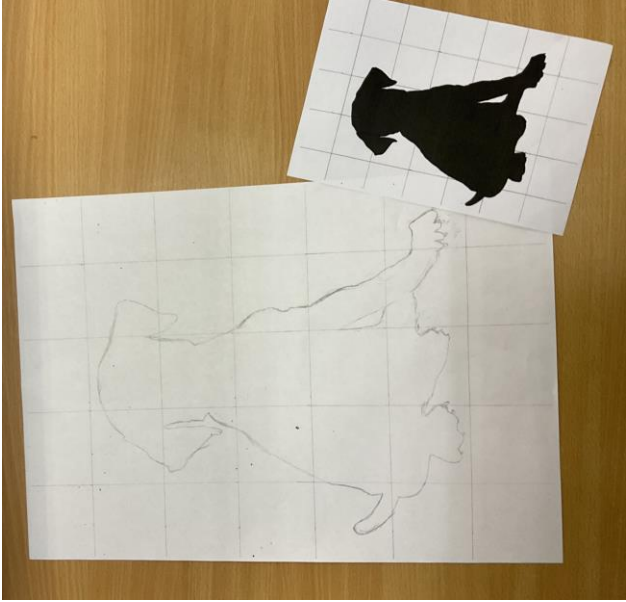


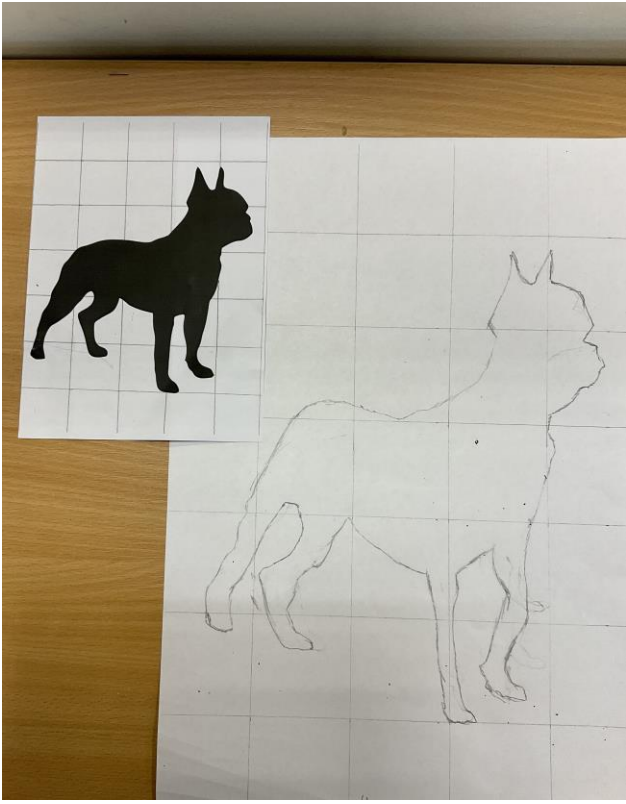
UKS2

After completing their study on the circulatory system, the UKS2 students are now discussing strategies to maintain a healthy body. They have actively conducted investigations into the effects of exercise, thought about the significance of a nutritious diet, regular physical activity, and a healthy lifestyle.

In Year 6, the students are still relishing their time spent with reading buddies. In the latest session, they enthusiastically exchanged stories they had written, further enhancing their literacy skills and strengthening the bond between them.


Our art topic this term is on 2D and 3D shapes. The children used their knowledge of negative and positive spaces alongside the grid method to create scaled up drawings of dog silhouettes. Through this exercise the children learnt to trust what they see and to appreciate the relationship of 'part' to 'whole'.

Competition Details
Children in Year 5 are invited to enter a piece of either 2D or 3D artwork on the subject of 'Portrait'. The work can be completed in any medium including: paint, pencil crayon, pastel, collage, ink, textiles, plaster, clay, computer graphics and mixed media. Two dimensional work should be between A4 and A2, and three dimensional work should be able to fit in an area 2ft square (approx).



ENFORCING PARKING RESTRICTIONS

We are asking for your cooperation in making sure that children are safe when they go to school.

Cars that are parked irresponsibly by those dropping off children are causing problems for other road users, residents and pedestrians who need to get to school.

Traffic and parking issues during school times have been raised as a concern by parents, staff, residents and other children who attend the schools concerned.

We are working with schools in your area to stop irresponsible parking as we need to act now and work together to resolve this serious issue.

We are sending a leaflet to all parents/guardians to inform them that enforced parking restrictions will be put in place and that anyone who continues to park irresponsibly will receive a fixed penalty notice.

All road users need to be aware of and adhere to parking restrictions:

- No parking on bends
- No parking on zigzag lines
- Do not obstruct a resident's driveway
- Do not park on double lines
- Do not park on 'time restricted' single lines
- Do not cause an obstruction
