Reception

In Reception, we read 'Grandad's Farm' and discussed the jobs that need to be done on a farm. We then talked about the different times of the year which are important for farmers, such as harvest time or when it's time to sow seeds. We identified the changes on a farm during spring, summer, autumn and winter. In maths, we have been recognising, continuing and building simple patterns.









KS1

In DT this week, the KS1 children have made some healthy fruit salads after learning about what foods are healthy for us. The children used many different fruits: blueberries, oranges, apples, melon and strawberries. They cut up the fruit independently and had lots of fun tasting their finished salads. This week, our Year 4 scientists have been exploring sound! The children investigated how sounds are created and discovered that many come from vibrations. One of the highlights was making rice jump on a drum—such a fun way to see sound waves in action! We also used a tuning fork to send water squirting out of a pot, which caused plenty of excitement!

In English, we've been diving deep into the world of blue whales, uncovering incredible facts to present our findings. A highlight was heading out onto the school field to measure the full length of a blue whale! The children were absolutely amazed to see just how enormous these gentle giants really are.













UKS2

This week, our indoor PE lessons have focused on refining our straddle, forward, and backward rolls. We've been using momentum to enhance our movement and maintaining strong body tension to perfect our shapes. While the playground is being improved, we've swapped tennis lessons for rounders on the field. We've been working on our throwing and catching under pressure before applying these skills in a striking and fielding game.

In Computing, we've wrapped up filming our interviews with a famous person and are excited to edit and piece them together next week using the Clips app. Meanwhile, in English, we've been planning and writing our own versions of The Selfish Giant, incorporating fantastic descriptive features to bring our stories to life.

It's been a busy and creative week—well done, everyone!


Unfortunately, we were unable to secure a supplier this year. We apologise for the disappointment this may cause, but we will be back again in 2026!




